Dear Parents,

Governor Herbert and State Superintendent Dickson issued a statement this afternoon announcing that "...Utah's K-12 public schools will extend their dismissal through Friday, May 1st..."

Our teachers have been instructed to continue to deliver school work via technology until the May 1st date. We will further limit the number of employees at our school buildings and one-on-one appointments with teachers will need to be scheduled with the teachers. Meal services will continue to be offered to all of our students, free of charge and the "grab and go" lunches combined with breakfast for the following morning will be available at the south end of each building from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm.

Please note that Spring Break is scheduled from March 30 through April 3. The school will be closed, teachers will not be sending home any assignments and meals will not be available during those days.

Other than during Spring Break, the main office at each building will be open at the usual start time until 12:30 pm. This will allow you to come to school and pick up assignments in the lobby if needed. If you desire to check out a mobile device for your child, please contact the teacher at least 24 hours ahead of time so that the teacher can get the device to the main office for you to pick up. It will need to be picked up by a parent who will also need to sign the mobile device agreement. A secretary will be in the office to assist you.

We greatly appreciate your wonderful support and patience as we try to do the best we can to get through this disruptive time. Please stay safe. We will send out periodical emails to keep you updated if the situation changes.
